COVID-19 Testing

to ensure safe celebrations.

Testing is being provided for state employees and contractors through a partnership with First Care Clinics. Employees and contractors can receive COVID-19 testing at any of the 13 First Care Clinics' testing sites throughout the state or the drive-thru testing site located at the Sower Building in Frankfort.

The remaining testing dates below have been adjusted to 3-day sessions. With supervisor prior-approval, all Executive Branch state employees will be given up to two (2) hours, with reasonable drivetime, to register for and complete their test at any of the locations:

It's that time again! Open Enrollment for 2021 is from October 12-28, 2020.

Everyone is encouraged to enroll in health, dental, and vision benefits. *If* you do not enroll during the Open Enrollment period, you will remain in the same plan option and coverage level as you have now, except for FSA and the Waiver General Purpose HRA.

Due to federal rules, you must take action if you want an FSA, or if you want the employer-funded Waiver General Purpose HRA – up to \$2,100. Just go to KHRIS.ky.gov and log into KHRIS Employee Self-Service (ESS).
