MAKING THE MOST OF YOUR DONATION AND SERVING THE MOST KENTUCKIANS

The KECC Charities undergo rigorous scrutiny by the Personnel Cabinet and have met stringent guidelines. They are well-managed and accountable, and they help people right here in the Commonwealth. These federations represent nearly a thousand charitable programs... they touch all our lives.

You can give to any 501(c)(3), however, since the partner charities share the full cost of providing the campaign, there is a 10 percent cost recovery charged to non-partner charities to help offset processing these pledges. To avoid this, you may wish to donate directly to that charity or consider giving to one of the KECC partner charities. To help hold down administrative costs, these gifts to other "write-in" charities must be at least a \$50 cash gift or a payroll gift of \$3 per paycheck.

Cash pledges are sent in the first quarter following the end of the campaign. Because payroll deduction allows you to spread your donation over the course of a year, we put your gift to use right away -- donations to the partner charities or any agency they support are sent quarterly. Other "write-in" designations will be sent after all of the payroll deductions have been collected.
