Re: State of Emergency / Floods – FLSA Status

To ensure consistency in our personnel policies, protocols, and HR applications across the enterprise, and as a follow-up to Governor Beshear's Executive Order <u>2025-210</u>, declaring a State of Emergency due to the severe weather that began April 2, 2025, causing flooding across the Commonwealth, please be advised of the following:

## **FLSA Status**

Appointing authorities may temporarily change the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) status of non-policy making positions from "Exempt" to "Non-Exempt" status, if the majority of the job duties of the position are being performed in response to the State of Emergency.

This change may be effective retroactively to April 2, 2025 and may remain in effect until rescission of this directive.
