**ORDER OF THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE  
ALLEN COUNTY, KENTUCKY**

Comes now Johnny Hobdy, Judge/Executive, Allen County, Kentucky and makes the following Findings and Order:



1. Whereas a Local Option Petition was filed with the Allen County Clerk on October 31, 2016; and,
2. Whereas KRS 242.020 requires a Local Option Petition to be signed by a number of constitutionally qualified voters of the territory to be affected, equal to 25% of the votes cast in the territory at the last proceeding general election; and,
3. Whereas the area affected by the Petition is all of Allen County, Kentucky and the number of signatures necessary for a valid Petition would be 857; and,
4. Whereas it appears that there are 865 names of constitutionally qualified voters of Allen County on the Petition;
5. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Allen County Clerk conduct a Local Option (Wet/Dry) election in Allen County, Kentucky on January 24, 2017. Further, in accordance with KRS 242.050 the votes shall designate a "yes" or a "no" vote to the proposition which shall read as follows:

"Are you in favor of the sale of alcoholic beverages in Allen County, Kentucky?"
